Application Deadline	The Scholarship application will be made available online on May 1st, 2022. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST May 31st, 2022 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.		
Eligibility Criteria	 Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of 		
	Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.

Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing

The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.

- 1. The maximum scholarship award is \$2,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$100 per course beginning with the student's first attended course in the Initial Attendance Window and thereafter for those continuously attended courses in their bachelor's program until: (i) the student has maximized the \$2,000 Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years has elapsed from the student's first date of attendance in the their first course, or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as "Terminating Events".
- 2. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix.

Maintenance Requirements

In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must meet the following maintenance requirements:

- 1. Applicant must remain in a bachelor's program (all coursework attended must be program applicable courses). Awards will only be applied to courses taken as part of their bachelor's program, specific to the original program level award.
- Applicant must successfully pass each course attempted in accordance with their program's requirements as outlined in the academic catalog for all courses. Any withdrawals or courses not successfully passed in accordance with the program requirements will terminate the scholarship.
- 3. Applicant may not have an unapproved attendance gap greater than 35 days.

Terms and Conditions
