## The Transfer Student Bachelor's Scholarship – November 2022

Summary	All new students who transfer to the University of Phoenix and who (i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have completed and transfer in at least 13 but no more than 60 credits combined transfer credits from accredited institution(s); and (iii) apply for this Transfer Student Bachelor's Scholarship – November 2022 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between November 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022 and November 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship up to \$3,000 each.
Application Deadline	The Scholarship application will be made available online on October 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST November 30 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 ("Application Deadline"). Applications
	submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.
Eligibility Criteria	<ol> <li>Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.</li> </ol>
	2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.
	3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc.
	4. Applicant must not have previously attended University of Phoenix.
	<ol> <li>Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program.</li> </ol>

6. As part of the application, the University of Phoenix will obtain official transcripts from previous institutions. These transcripts will verify the following requirements:

No scholarship funds will be applied to previous classes or currently enrolled classes at the time of scholarship award. No check or other cash monies will be disbursed at any time. No exceptions.

  - c. Recipient is out of attendance on an unapproved leave of absence for more than 35 days.
  - d. Recipient completes their bachelor's degree program.
  - e. Receives the maximum scholarship award
  - f. 730 days from a recipient's first course.
